Celebrating its 6th year since inception, the bent grass greens, kikuyu fairways a long Par 3 (200m) challenging Par 4s, long Par 5s and water features offers an enjoyable challenge. The course can be best described as a "You snooze you lose" kind of course.





Ceila Resort and Spa epitomises the contemporary spirit of Africa Rising. The 249 room designer hotel is set in a tranquil, scenic 100 hectare estate which includes a premier 18 hole golf layout called Bonanza Golf Course. The property is also home to the Lusaka International Convention Centre, a luxury spa, a gym, a craft beer brewery and a choice of fantastic dining experiences. - 1. A valid passport is required with a minimum of 2 blank pages at the end of the passport.
- 2. At road border. Zambia road levy and temporary import permit to be paid. Must carry vehicle registration document/whitebook. Interpol clearance and Insurance required.
- 3. The currency used in Zambia is Kwacha. Current rate is approx ZMW27.5 USD\$1 or ZMW1.5/ ZAR1.00. Please only change your currency at a reputable forex bureau or bank.
- 4. English is the standard common communication, People are friendly and helpful.
- 5. Drinking Water. Please only drink bottled water. Please stay hydrated as Lusaka only has two seasons this tournament will be played in the dry season.
- 6. Skin Protection. Please bring sunscreen. There is little cloud cover in July so please ensure you stay protected. Carry a jacket as the evenings can be a bit nippy.
- 7. Malaria. Zambia is a malaria zone. Although mosquitos are not prevalent in the winter, please take the necessary precautions.
- 8. International roaming works in Zambia, please activate the same with your serviceprovider before you leave your country of origin or you can acquire a local sim at the port of entry.
- Shuttle service. For those who are staying at the Ciela Resort, the golf course is within walking distance or you can grab a hotel shuttle. Shuttle timetables from the airport will be announced closer to the tournament.

COURSE RULES AND NOMADS ETIQUETTE

Players to check in daily at the registration desk at least 30 minutes before their allocated tee-off time and report to the starter at least 10 minutes before tee-off. The first player in each four-ball is the nominated captain and is responsible for maintaining the teams position within the field and handing in the cards along with ZMW20 for the worst player in the four-ball. He must kindly remain at the score control desk for card checking. Please honour all local club rules.

RULES INTERPRETATION AND DISCIPLINARY MATTERS

Any member of the Tournament Committee will be available to assist in matters relating to rule interpretation and possible disciplinary issues.

CADDY FEES AND CARTS

The minimum caddy fee is **ZMW200** per round payable in cash directly to the caddy. Tip is optional. Halfway vouchers for caddies will be handed out at registration. Golf carts are limited so please can coordinators kindly motivate and prioritise their requirements. The cost of a cart will be ZMW600 per round.

PRACTICE AREAS

There is a practice range, short game practice green and putting green adjacent to the clubhouse. Practice balls can be purchased from the Pro Shop.

BAG STORAGE

Golf bags may be stored overnight in a lock up facility at the club. This will be free of charge and tags will be issued at registration. This facility will be available from 06:00hrs to 20:00hrs on Thursday 18th & Friday 19th and from 06:00hrs to 18:00hrs on Saturday 21st. No bags will be accepted for storage on Sunday.

Both Visa and Mastercard ATM facilities are available at the Club.

Registration will be at the Ciela Resort on Wednesday 17th 10:30hrs to 16:30hrs.
