Captain's Corner:



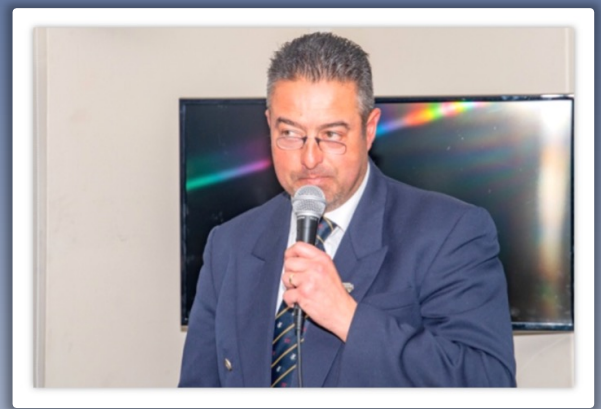
Fellow Nomads, herewith my report for August.

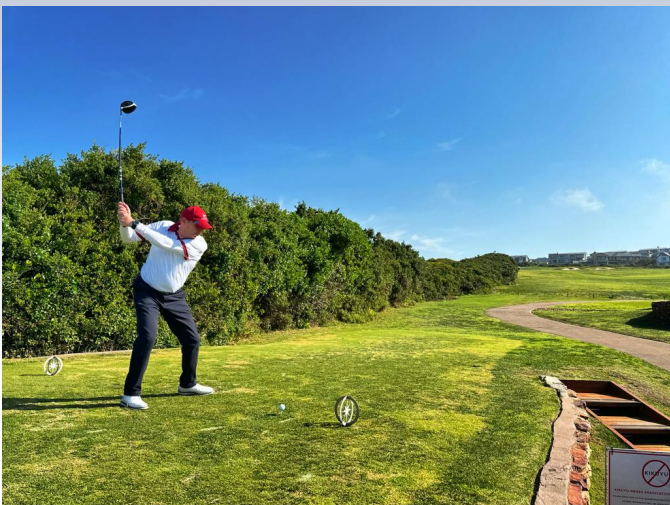

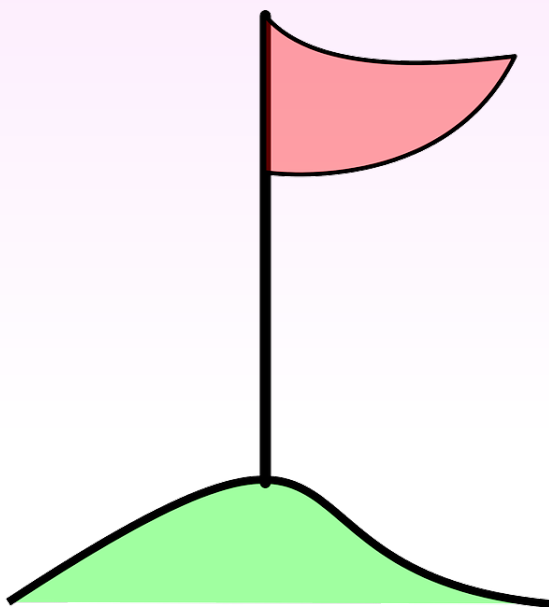

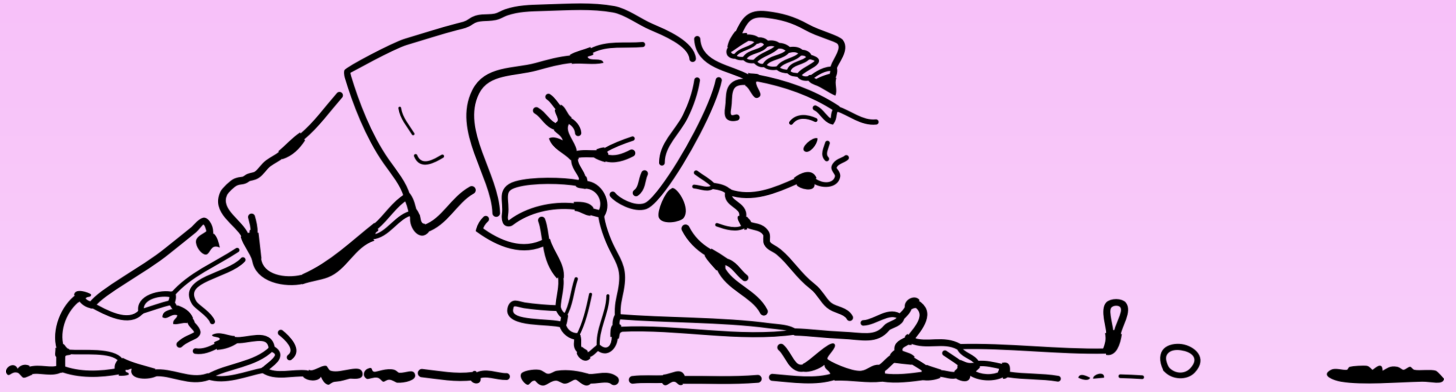
